

Noise Awareness and Assessment

Introduction

An introductory course dealing with the legal requirements relating to noise at work. Designed for those identified as having a responsibility for workplace risk assessment, the course will provide a basic understanding of the principles and pitfalls in the assessment and control of noise.

Course Content

The course covers the current regulations for noise exposure in the workplace, noise measuring equipment and its use in practice, risk assessment based on daily noise exposures derived from information on measured noise levels and work patterns, development of skills in decibel arithmetic, identifying situations where noise hazards exist, selecting suitable hearing protection and understanding basic noise control techniques.

- Understanding of the legal requirements relating to noise in the workplace
- Understanding of how to carry out a noise survey
- Review methods of noise control
- Review types of personal protective equipment (PPE) and when this should be used
